- Participate in training for all health care staff, as part of ongoing education, continuous quality assurance and new personnel orientation.
- Maintain compliance with coding, billing, documentation and patient services.
- Complete nutrient programs and other medical services in timely fashion, within guidelines established by the Executive Director.
- Offer clinical support to nursing and pharmacy staff.
- May initiate and/or participate in research projects in cooperation with the Director of Research and approved by the Executive Director.
- Participate in educational and community service seminars regarding the Pfeiffer Treatment Center.
- Perform additional related duties as assigned by the Director of Clinical Operations.
- Render services in a competent, efficient, and professional manner in accordance with applicable law and comply with all relevant professional and ethical standards regarding the practice of medicine.
- Abide by the Corporation's administrative policies and procedures.

Requirements

- Masters of Science in Nursing required
- Nurse Practitioner Certification required, Family Nurse Practitioner Certification preferred
- Three or more years professional experience as a nurse practitioner preferred
- Clinical experience in the evaluation and management of the symptoms and co-morbid medical conditions associated with behavior, mood, learning and thought disorders addressed by the methodology of the Pfeiffer Treatment Center.
- Skills and ability to work as part of a medical team comprised of physicians, pharmacists, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, registered dietitians, and registered nurses.
- Ability to work with registered nurses acting in a case manager capacity.
- Flexibility in days and hours available for scheduled work, including weekends and occasional travel
 out of state to provide clinic outreach services.
